- ❖ Supported browse : Chrome, Microsoft edge, Firefox



How To Install InstagramFeed ?

Install using composer:

1. composer require aimsinfosoft/module-instagramfeed
2. php bin/magento setup:upgrade
3. php bin/magento setup:di:compile
4. php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy -f

Install Manually:

1. Download Extension from store.
2. Add zip file in app/code/Aimsinfosoft/InstagramFeed folder and extract it and run below commands
3. php bin/magento setup:upgrade
4. php bin/magento setup:di:compile
5. php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy -f

How Instagram Feed works?

- Display your Instagram posts beautifully in your Magento store. Engage visitors, grow followers, and add a modern touch to your site.

Configuration:

=> General

- After successfully installing the extension.
- Go to **Admin Panel > Stores > Configuration > Instagram Feed**.
- In the **General** section, set **Enable** to **Yes**.
- In the **User Token** field, enter your **Instagram Access Token**.
You can generate this token from Facebook Developers (required to fetch Instagram posts).
- Enter your **Instagram Business Account ID** in the **Business Account Id** field.

=> Display Settings

- **Total Number of Posts** → Set how many Instagram posts you want to display on the storefront.
- **Display On Pages** → This option allows you to choose on which pages the Instagram Feed should be displayed.
You can select one or multiple pages from the list: **Homepage, Category Page, Product Page, Cart Page**.
- **Display Position** → This option defines where on the page the Instagram Feed will appear.
Available positions may vary depending on your theme, but typically include:
After Page Header Container – Displays the feed below the header.
Before Page Footer Container – Displays the feed above the footer.
6. Custom – Allows you to place the feed manually in a CMS Page, CMS Block, or `.phtml` file using the provided code snippet.

Example for CMS Page/Block:

```
{{block class="Aimsinfosoft\InstagramFeed\Block\Widget"  
template="Aimsinfosoft_InstagramFeed::instagram.phtml"}}
```

Example for .phtml file:


- **Show Pop-up** → Set to **Yes** if you want a popup to appear when users click on an Instagram image.

Access Token Steps

- Open Graph API Explorer. <https://developers.facebook.com/tools/explorer/>
- At the top, select your **App**.
- Select the permissions you need (checkboxes). Example:
`pages_show_list`, `instagram_basic`, `instagram_manage_insights`
- Click **Generate Access Token**.
- A popup will open → log in with your Facebook account → allow permissions.
- You now have a **short-lived User Access Token** (valid for ~1 hour).

Steps to Get App ID and App Secret :

- Open Meta for Developers <https://developers.facebook.com/tools/explorer/>
- Log in with the Facebook account that manages your Page/Business.
- Go to Dashboard of your app
- You will see **App ID** listed at the top.



Get Your App Secret

- In the Dashboard, click Settings → Basic.
- You'll see App Secret (hidden by default).
- Click “**Show**” → Enter your Facebook password → Copy the **App Secret**.
